

## **CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS FOR COMMUNITY PERSPECTIVES:**

The Journal of Community Engagement and Scholarship (JCES) is a refereed journal, that provides a mechanism through which faculty, staff, and students of academic institutions and their community partners disseminate scholarly works from all academic disciplines. A goal of JCES is to encourage the integration of teaching, research, and community engagement. Each issue of JCES attempts to publish at least one community partner submission.

Community partners working with academic partners from all disciplines are invited to submit original work to the Community Perspectives section of JCES. All forms of writing, analysis, creative approaches, and methodologies are acceptable for the journal. Specific types of submissions appropriate for the Community Perspectives section include commentaries, critical reflections, and opinion pieces related to community engagement and/or engaged scholarship. Given that engagement scholarship is such an interdisciplinary field in which all appropriate ways to best “tell the story” are not known, scholarly contributions of any kind related to the field of engagement scholarship are welcome and will be considered for publication in JCES.

Community Perspective submissions are accepted on an ongoing basis. Manuscripts should be between 750-2000 words in length.
